We hope this material will continue to minister as the sermon was preached during our weekly worship service. When we receive God's Word at church, we need not only to hear the message, but we ought to walk it out in our daily lives. We should "be doers of the word, not only hearers." (James 1:22)

Step 1: GET TOGETHER with your family or group.

Step 2: REVIEW the key points and scriptures from the message.

Step 3: SHARE with your group what God is saying to you through the message.

Step 4: PRAY together, for each other and over each other to continue to walk this word out.

The Big Idea

This week, we delve into the concept of discovering our purpose and identity. Before we can understand our purpose, we must first grasp who we are and why we exist. Ultimately, our purpose is not merely to exist but to be set on fire with a divine mission that glorifies God and impacts the world around us.

Don't Miss This Point!

Read Exodus 3:1-6. Just as Moses was drawn to the burning bush, we are called to identify the areas that ignite our hearts and fuel our enthusiasm.

First, it is crucial to understand our passion when working towards discovering our purpose! By recognizing and embracing our passions, we can align ourselves with God's purpose and unlock the fullness of our divine calling. Through this alignment, we position ourselves to experience the anointing and empowerment necessary to fulfill our God-given destiny.

Another Great Point!

There is great significance in identifying the problems we are uniquely positioned to solve. While many shy away from challenges, God calls us to be problem solvers rather than problem seers. By acknowledging and addressing the problems around us, we step into our purpose and become agents of transformation in our communities.

One Last Point!

It is an absolute necessity to embrace seasons of preparation as integral to the fulfillment of our purpose. Sometimes preparation happens in prime seasons.

Just as Moses spent years in the wilderness before being commissioned by God, we too must undergo a process of refinement and preparation. This season of preparation may involve discomfort, separation, and practice, but it ultimately positions us for the manifestation of God's purpose in our lives.
